Consumers may be buying into Windows Vista, but they really don't have a choice, most new PCs come with the latest version of windows preinstalled. However, many corporate users are still pulling off plans to mitigate to Microsoft's new desktop operating system.

Even the release of the first 'service pack' of bug fixes for Vista-typically a signal for broader corporate adoption of windows systems - has been shrugged off by several IT managers. Some users who are holding back have cited vista costs, increased hardware specifications and lack of pressing business needs as factors in their decisions.

"We have not moved to Vista, and we have no plans to. As far as I am concerned, this is an upgrade that offers nothing to a business customer." said one C.I.O. "The cost is very high to upgrade, and there's not a lot of perceived value" says another.

A product manager for windows explained, Microsoft is focussing on communicating the benefits of windows Vista to companies still running older operating systems. Those benefits include improved stability and enhanced security management features apart - from better user interface.

Large companies face bigger obstacles to upgrading because of the sheer volume of PCs involved. A company running windows 2000 and Windows XP feels they are 'quite reliable' and sees no need to move to Vista.

The fact is, many corporate users bought Microsoft's sales pitch on the windows NT based operating systems and revolutionary improvements built into



Windows 2000/XP. Now that they have installed Windows 2000/XP, they are in no mood to switch to what they view as marginal improvements.
